An Act to amend The Dairymen's Act

(Assented to _____, 1970)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Dairymen's Act* is hereby amended.
2. Section 2 is amended by striking out clauses (b), (d), (e), (f), (g), (j), (q) and (s) and by substituting the following:
 - (g) "dairy manufacturing plant" means an establishment in which a dairy product is manufactured, processed, reprocessed, packed or repacked;
3. Section 15 is amended by striking out the words "manufacturing or processing plant," and by substituting the words "dairy manufacturing plant,".
4. Section 37 is amended by striking out subsection (2) and by substituting the following:
 - (2) The chairman and members of an advisory board
 - (a) hold office during the pleasure of the Minister, and
 - (b) may be paid such expenses and such remuneration as may be prescribed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.
5. Section 48 is amended
 - (a) as to subsection (1) by striking out the words "Minister, with the approval of the",
 - (b) by striking out subsection (2).
6. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill amends chapter 74 of the Revised Statutes.

2. "Dairy manufacturing plant" is redefined to relate it to the definition of dairy product. Clauses (g) and (h) presently read:

- (g) "dairy manufacturing plant" means a dairy, cheese factory, creamery, concentrated milk plant, ice cream plant, process cheese plant or skimming station or any combination thereof;
- (h) "dairy product" means milk, cream, butter, cheese, ice cream, condensed milk, evaporated milk, milk powder, dry milk, malted milk, sherbet or any other article manufactured wholly or mainly from milk;

The other clauses being struck out define the factories and plants referred to in the present clause (g). These defined terms are not used elsewhere in the Act.

3. Section 15 reads in part:

15. No person shall sell, supply or send to a dairy manufacturing plant, or any premises where milk or cream is collected for sale or shipment to a manufacturing or processing plant,
- (a) milk diluted with water or in any way adulterated, or

4. Section 37, subsection (2) presently reads:

- (2) The chairman and members of an advisory board
 - (a) hold office during the pleasure of the Minister,
 - (b) shall receive such expenses as may be approved by the Minister, and
 - (c) shall not receive any remuneration for their services.

5. Section 48(1) reads in part

48. (1) The Minister, with the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, may make regulations

The change simplifies procedures by removing the necessity for both a Ministerial Order and an Order in Council. Subsection (2) requires the regulations to be published in the Alberta Gazette and is redundant in view of the effect of The Regulations Act.
