An Act to amend The Domestic Relations Act

(*Assented to* , 1970)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1.** *The Domestic Relations Act* is hereby amended.
- 2.** Section 27, subsection (3) is amended by adding after the words "upon the magistrate who dealt with the matter" the words "and upon the opposite party".
- 3.** This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill amends The Domestic Relations Act, R.S.A. 1955, c. 89.

2. This amendment requires an appellant to serve notice upon the opposite party as well as the magistrate who dealt with the matter from which an appeal is to be taken.
