### BILL 8

An Act to amend The Women's Cultural and Information Bureau Act

(Assented to , 1970)

TER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Women's Cultural and Information Bureau Act is hereby amended.
  - **2.** Section 1 is struck out and the following is substituted:
- 1. This Act may be cited as The Alberta Women's Bureau Act.
- 3. Section 2 is amended by striking out clause (a) and substituting the following:
  - (a) "Bureau" means the Alberta Women's Bureau established by this Act;
- 4. Section 3, subsection (1) is amended by striking out the words "Women's Cultural and Information Bureau" and by substituting the words "Alberta Women's Bureau".
- **5.** Section 4 is amended by striking out the words "Women's Cultural and Information Bureau" and by substituting the words "Alberta Women's Bureau".
- 6. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

### **Explanatory Notes**

- 1. This Bill amends chapter 109 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1966.
- 2. This amendment changes the short title of the Act in accordance with a change in the name of the Bureau.
  - 3. Changes definition of Bureau to new name.
  - 4. Establishes the Alberta Women's Bureau in its new name.
  - 5. Amends the Bureau name in the Director's title.
