HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The County Act is hereby amended.
- **2.** Section 3, subsection (1), clause (c) is amended by striking out the words "an odd number".
- 3. Section 16 is amended by striking out subsection (3) and by substituting the following:
- (3) A person who is an elector of a school district that is not included in the county for school purposes is not eligible to be elected or appointed and shall not be appointed to the school committee.

4. Section 17 is amended

- (a) by striking out subsection (3a) and substituting the following:
 - (3a) The term of office of a person elected pursuant to this section shall be for a period of time similar to that of a councillor as determined by The Municipal Election Act or until his successor is sworn into office.
- (b) as to subsection (3a1) by striking out the words "the date of such election" and by substituting the words "being advised in writing by the municipal secretary of the town or village of his election".
- 5. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

- 1. This Bill will amend chapter 64 of the Revised Statutes.
- 2. Section 3, subsection (1), clause (c) presently reads:
 - - (c) fix the number of councillors to be elected to the county council, which number shall be an odd number not in excess of eleven, and
- 3. Section 16, subsection (3) presently reads:
- (3) A person who is an elector of a separate school district is not eligible to be elected or appointed and shall not be appointed to the school committee unless the separate school district is included in the county for school purposes by way of agreement pursuant to The School Act.
- 4. Section 17, subsections (3a) and (3a1) presently read:
 - (3a) The term of office of a person elected pursuant to this section shall be for a period of three years commencing at the date of the first meeting of the council which he represents following the date fixed for the general election or until his successor is sworn into office.
- (3a1) Where a person elected pursuant to this section is entitled to be appointed to the school committee, the county council shall appoint him to the school committee at its first regular meeting held after the date of such election.
