# BILL 14

An Act to amend The Alberta Freight Bureau Act

(Assented to

, 1970)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Alberta Freight Bureau Act is hereby amended.
- 2. Section 6 is struck out and the following is substituted:
- **6.** (1) In accordance with *The Public Service Act, 1968* there may be appointed such employees as are necessary for the carrying out of the duties of the Bureau and for the transaction of its business.
- (2) The director may, with the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, obtain the services of such accountants, economists, rates experts and other persons as the director considers necessary for the carrying out of the duties of the Bureau and for the transaction of its business.
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

### **Explanatory Notes**

- 1. This Bill will amend chapter 121 of the Revised Statutes.
- 2. Section 6 presently reads:
  - 6. Subject to The Public Service Act, the director
  - (a) may appoint such officers, servants and employees as the director deems necessary for the carrying out of the duties of the Bureau or for the transaction of its business, and prescribe their duties, conditions of employment and remuneration, and
  - (b) may with the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council obtain the services of such accountants, economists, rate experts and other professional persons as the director deems necessary for the carrying out of the duties of the Bureau or for the proper and convenient transaction of its business.
