HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Guarantees Acknowledgment Act, 1969 is amended as to section 3 by striking out clause (a) and by substituting the following:
 - (a) appears before a notary public,
- 2. The form set out in the Schedule is amended by striking out clause 3 thereof.
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

- 1. This Bill will amend chapter 41 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1969. Section 3 (a) presently reads:
 - 3. No guarantee has any effect unless the person entering into the obligation $% \left\{ 1,2,\ldots ,n\right\}$
 - (a) appears before a notary public who is not acting for the person to whom the obligation was incurred,
 - 2. Clause 3 of the form reads:
 - 3. I am not acting for the person to whom the obligation was incurred.
