An Act to amend The Administrative Procedures Act

(Assented to , 1970)

H^{ER} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Administrative Procedures Act is hereby amended.

2. Section 3 is struck out and the following section is substituted:

3. This Act applies to each and every authority.

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill amends chapter 1 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1966.

2. Section 3 presently reads:

- 3. The Lieutenant Governor in Council may, by order,(a) designate any authority as an authority to which this Act applies in whole or in part,
- (b) designate the statutory power of the authority in respect of which this Act applies in whole or in part, and
 (c) designate the provisions of this Act which are applicable to the authority in the exercise of that statutory power, and the extent to which they apply,
 (d) this Act apple to app authority to the extent ordered under

and this Act only applies to any authority to the extent ordered under this section.

The existing section provides that the Act is applicable only to those authorities which are designated by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

The amendment will make the Act applicable to all authorities.
