An Act to amend The Planning Act

(Assented to _____, 1970)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta,
enacts as follows:

1. *The Planning Act* is hereby amended.

2. Section 128 is amended by adding the following subsection:

(8) A decision of the development appeal board becomes null and void if construction of the project subject to appeal is not commenced within 2 years from the date of the decision.

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

- 1.** This Bill amends chapter 43 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1963.
- 2.** The amendment places a time limit within which applicants must act on decisions.
