An Act to amend The Alberta Labour Act

(Assented to _____, 1970)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Alberta Labour Act* is hereby amended.

2. The following section is added after section 80a:

80b. Notwithstanding anything in this Act, where the parties to a collective agreement have included in it any of the provisions permitted by subsection (2) of section 80 or by any of the regulations issued under this Act, an employee who satisfies the Minister to the extent that he declares and explains in an affidavit that his basic beliefs prevent him as a matter of conscience from being a member of or paying dues or contributions to the trade union that is a party to the collective agreement and that he will authorize the employer who is a party to the collective agreement to deduct from his wages for remittance to a registered Canadian charitable organization, as defined in the *Income Tax Act*, an amount at least equal to the dues that a member of the trade union is required to pay, shall not be subject to any of the provisions permitted by subsection (2) of section 80 or by any of the regulations issued under this Act.

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
