An Act to amend The Daylight Saving Time Act

(Assented to , 1970)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Daylight Saving Time Act* is hereby amended.
2. Section 4 is amended by adding the following subsection:
(4) In any year following a year in which subsection (1) of section 7 was not proclaimed to be in force, should a petition, signed by at least 20,000 electors in the Province be presented to the Lieutenant-Governor in Council before May 1st of that year, requesting a trial run for Daylight Saving Time, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may proclaim subsection (1) of section 7 to be in force throughout the Province for the year in which the petition was received.
3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

- 1.** This Bill amends Chapter 76 of the Revised Statutes.
- 2.** Subsection (1) of section 7 provides for the proclamation of Daylight Saving Time throughout the Province.
