An Act to amend The Alberta Labour Act

(Assented to _____, 1970)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Alberta Labour Act* is hereby amended.
2. Section 110 is amended as to subsections (2) and (3) by striking out the word "may" and by substituting the word "shall".
3. The following section is added after section 112:
112a. No information furnished to or received by an inspector or the Board under this Act, pursuant to section 110, subsection (1) or (2), shall be disclosed to anyone except the Board.
4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill will amend chapter 167 of the Revised Statutes to revise sections of Part 6 which deals with Equal Pay for Female Employees for identical or substantially identical work.

2. Section 110 presently reads:

110. (1) A female employee may make a complaint in writing to the Chairman that the employee has been paid a lesser rate of pay than that to which she was entitled to under section 103.

(2) The Chairman may designate an inspector who shall investigate the complaint and endeavour to effect a settlement.

(3) Where the inspector is unable to effect a settlement the Chairman may refer the complaint to the Board.
