An Act to amend The Snow Vehicles Act

(Assented to

, 1970)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Snow Vehicles Act is hereby amended.
- **2.** Section 9 is amended by striking out the words "front of" and by substituting the words "front or rear of".
 - 3. Section 10 is amended
 - (a) by striking out subsection (1) and by substituting the following:
 - 10. (1) The Registrar may issue identification number plates
 - (a) to manufacturers of and dealers in snow vehicles, and
 - (b) to persons engaged in the business of servicing snow vehicles kept for sale by manufacturers or dealers.
 - (b) as to subsection (4) by adding the word "or" at the end of clause (b) and by adding the following after clause (b):
 - (c) except a snow vehicle that is, for the time being, in the custody and control of a person engaged in the business of servicing snow vehicles in behalf of a manufacturer or dealer.
 - **4.** The following section is added after section 21:
- **21**a. Any person who permits another person to operate a snow vehicle in contravention of this Act or the regulations is guilty of an offence.

Explanatory Notes

- 1. This Bill amends chapter 100 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1969.
- 2. Section 9 requires the placement of the identification number plate on the front of the snow vehicle. It is impractical to place the identification number plate on the front of some models whereas in others it is impractical to attach the identification number plate on the rear. This amendment permits a choice of mounting location.
- 3. Section 10, subsection (1) and subsection (4), clause (b) read:
 - 10. (1) The Registrar may issue identification number plates to manufacturers of, dealers in, and persons who repair or service, snow vehicles.
 - (4) No person shall attach an identification number plate issued pursuant to this section to any vehicle,
 (b) except a snow vehicle used by a manufacturer or dealer for the promotion of sales of snow vehicles.

4. Offence.

- **5.** Section 24 is amended by adding the following clauses after clause (e):
 - (e1) prescribing rates of speed for snow vehicles,
 - (e2) prescribing rules of operation for snow vehicles and any other matter or thing considered necessary for the safety of operators, passengers or other persons,
 - (e3) prescribing any equipment required and the types and uses therefor
 - (i) on a snow vehicle,
 - (ii) by a driver and passengers on a snow vehicle, and
 - (iii) by passengers on any vehicle being drawn by a snow vehicle,
 - (e4) governing, restriting or prohibiting the operation of a snow vehicle by any person under a specified age,
- 6. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

5. Proposed amendment to section 24 permits the Lieutenant Governor in Council to enact regulations in the interests of safety governing the operation of snow vehacles.
