An Act respecting Native Peoples Day

(Assented to _____, 1970)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1.** This Act may be cited as *The Native Peoples Day Act*.
- 2.** “Native Peoples” will be defined as including those people of Indian or Eskimo racial extraction.
- 3.** The first Monday in August shall be designated “Native Peoples Day”.
- 4.** This day shall be declared to be an annual public holiday.

Explanatory Notes

2. “Native Peoples” defined as being all those with Indian or Eskimo blood, including Metis.

3. “Native Peoples Day” shall be kept in recognition of the cultural contributions and importance of native people to the history and life of Alberta.
