HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- R.S.A. c. 167 1. The Alberta Labour Act is hereby amended.
- Amends s. 30 2. Section 30 is struck out and the following is substituted:

No employer or person acting on behalf of an employer shall terminate the employment of any person solely by reason of a garnishee, writ of execution, judgment or statement of claim involving collection of a debt or alleged debt, which has been served upon the employer of that person.

Coming into 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
