AN ACT TO AMEND THE WILDLIFE ACT

(Assented to _____, 1971)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Wildlife Act is hereby amended.*
- 2. Section 17 is amended as to clause (b) by striking out the word “, skunks”.*
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill amends chapter 391 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.

2. Skunks deleted from licence exemption. Section 17 (b) reads as follows:

17. Unless authorized by a licence or permit issued by the Minister pursuant to this Act or The Fur Farms Act or the regulations thereunder, no person shall

(b) keep in captivity any wildlife except rabbits, hares, skunks or squirrels,
