AN ACT TO AMEND THE SUMMARY CONVICTIONS ACT

(Assented to _____, 1971)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Summary Convictions Act is hereby amended.*
2. *Section 6 is amended as to subsection (1), subsection (3), clause (c) and subsection (4) by striking out the words “, or any regulation made under either of those Acts” and by substituting the words “or The Snow Vehicles Act, or any regulation made under any of those Acts”.*
3. *Section 7, subsection (6), clause (a) is amended by adding the word “and” at the end of subclause (ii) and by adding the following subclause after subclause (iii):*
 - (iv) The Snow Vehicles Act,
4. *This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill amends chapter 355 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.

2. Section 6 provides the authority for traffic ticket summons for use with contraventions of The Highway Traffic Act, The Public Service Vehicles Act, or any regulation made under either of those Acts. The proposed amendment extends the use of the traffic ticket summons to offences under The Snow Vehicles Act and the regulations thereunder.

3. Section 7 authorizes the system of voluntary payment of prescribed penalties in lieu of court appearances where traffic ticket summons are used for contravention of prescribed provisions of The Highway Traffic Act and The Public Service Vehicles Act. The amendment will make the system applicable to prescribed offences under The Snow Vehicles Act.
