AN ACT TO AMEND THE ALBERTA LORD'S DAY ACT

(Assented to

, 1971)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Alberta Lord's Day Act is hereby amended.
- 2. Section 5 is struck out and the following is substituted:
- **5.** This Act or a Sunday by-law does not authorize the providing, engaging in or attending at a horse race, dog race or boxing contest.
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

- 1. This Bill amends chapter 221 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.
 - 2. Section 5 presently reads:

5. This Act or a Sunday by-law does not authorize the providing, engaging in or attending at a horse race, dog race, boxing contest or exhibition of wrestling or any other like exhibition or contest.

The amendment allows wrestling on Sunday.
