## AN ACT TO AMEND THE ALBERTA LORD'S DAY ACT

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1971)

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Alberta Lord's Day Act is hereby amended.*
2. *Section 5 is struck out and the following is substituted:*
  5. This Act or a Sunday by-law does not authorize the providing, engaging in or attending at a horse race, dog race or boxing contest.
3. *This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*

## **Explanatory Notes**

**1.** This Bill amends chapter 221 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.

**2.** Section 5 presently reads:

5. This Act or a Sunday by-law does not authorize the providing, engaging in or attending at a horse race, dog race, boxing contest or exhibition of wrestling or any other like exhibition or contest.

The amendment allows wrestling on Sunday.
