AN ACT TO AMEND THE SALE OF CHATELS BY PUBLIC AUCTION ACT

(Assented to , 1971)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Sale of Chattels by Public Auction Act is hereby amended.*

2. *Section 4 is amended*

(a) *by adding the following subsection after subsection (1):*

(1.1) Subsection (1) does not apply to a religious or charitable organization exempted by the Minister.

(b) *by striking out subsection (3) and substituting the following:*

(3) No person shall act as an auctioneer at a sale by public auction of goods or chattels on behalf of an auction sales company unless the auction sales company holding the sale is a religious or charitable organization exempted by the Minister or is the holder of an auction sales business licence.

3. *This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill amends chapter 326 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.

2. The amendments permit a charitable or religious organization to hold an auction without first having to apply for an auction sales business licence and permits an auctioneer to act as an auctioneer for an auction held by a religious or charitable organization.
