AN ACT TO AMEND THE FAMILY COURT ACT

(Assented to _____ *, 1971)*

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Family Court Act is hereby amended.

2. Section 6 is amended by adding the following subsection after subsection (1):

(1.1) Where the person entitled to file and enforce a judgment or order under subsection (1)

(a) receives economic assistance from the Government of Alberta or a municipality in Alberta on his or her behalf or on behalf of a dependent child, and

(b) refuses to file or enforce the judgment or order, a welfare worker of the Government or municipality, as the case may be, may file and enforce the judgment or order.

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill amends chapter 133 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.

2. The amendment gives the Government or municipality the right to try and recover social allowance money paid to persons who could have enforced a maintenance or alimony order of the Supreme Court.
