THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AMENDMENT ACT, 1972

(Assented to _____, 1972)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Department of Education Act is hereby amended.*
2. *Section 5 is amended by striking out subsection (3).*
3. *Section 7, subsection (1) is amended*
 - (a) *by striking out clause (b) and by substituting the following:*
 - (b) *concerning the certification of teachers and the cancellation and suspension of certificates,*
 - (b) *by striking out clause (d) and by substituting the following:*
 - (d) *prescribing a tariff of fees payable for any service provided, research done or material provided by the Department,*
- 4 *This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill will amend chapter 96 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.

2. Section 5, subsection (3) presently reads:

(3) The Minister may appoint temporary, part-time or seasonal staff for such purposes as he considers necessary.

This subsection is unnecessary. There are similar provisions in The Public Service Act.

3. Section 7, subsection (1), clauses (b) and (d) presently read:

7. (1) The Minister may make regulations

.....

(b) concerning the certification of teachers,

(d) for the establishment, operation, administration and management of vocational or technical schools or institutes and prescribing fees or a schedule of fees to be charged for any matter connected with the vocational or technical school or institute,

The Department of Advanced Education will be responsible for the matters mentioned in the present clause (d).
