### THE APPRENTICESHIP AMENDMENT ACT, 1972

(Assented to

, 1972)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Apprenticeship Act is hereby amended.
- 2. Section 21 is amended
- (a) as to subsection (2), by striking out clause (c) and by substituting the following:
  - (c) prescribe, subject to subsection (2.1), the hours of labour and the rates of wages for apprentices.
- (b) by adding after subsection (2) the following subsection:
  - (2.1) The provisions of *The Alberta Labour Act* apply to apprentices but in no event shall the terms of a collective agreement vary any terms of employment of an apprentice established by the regulations of the Board.
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

### **Explanatory Notes**

- 1. This Bill will amend chapter 20 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.
  - 2. Section 21 (2) (c) presently reads:
    - (2) Without limiting the generality of subsection (1), the Board by regulation may
