THE APPRENTICESHIP AMENDMENT ACT, 1972

(Assented to _____, 1972)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Apprenticeship Act is hereby amended.*

2. *Section 21 is amended*

(a) *as to subsection (2), by striking out clause (c) and by substituting the following:*

(c) **prescribe, subject to subsection (2.1), the hours of labour and the rates of wages for apprentices,**

(b) *by adding after subsection (2) the following subsection:*

(2.1) **The provisions of *The Alberta Labour Act* apply to apprentices but in no event shall the terms of a collective agreement vary any terms of employment of an apprentice established by the regulations of the Board.**

3. *This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill will amend chapter 20 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.

2. Section 21 (2) (c) presently reads:

(2) Without limiting the generality of subsection (1), the Board by regulation may
(c) prescribe, subject to The Alberta Labour Act, the hours of labour the rates of wages for apprentices,
