#### THE ALCOHOLISM AND DRUG ABUSE AMENDMENT ACT, 1972

(Assented to

, 1972)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Alcoholism and Drug Abuse Act is hereby amended.
- 2. Section 3 is amended by striking out subsections (3), (4) and (5) and by substituting therefor the following subsections:
- (3) The Chairman of the Commission may receive from the Commission such remuneration and shall perform such duties as the Lieutenant Governor in Council may prescribe.
- (4) The Commission may pay to each member of the Commission, other than the Chairman, fees for attending meetings of the Commission, at the rates prescribed by the Minister.
- (5) The Commission may pay travelling and living expenses at the rates prescribed by the Minister to each member of the Commission while the member is absent from his ordinary place of residence in the course of his duties as a member of the Commission.
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

### **Explanatory Notes**

- 1. This Bill will amend chapter 16 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.
- 2. The remuneration of members will be governed by by-law. Section 3, subsections (3) to (5) read:
  - (3) The Commission may pay to each member of the Commission

  - (a) fees for attending meetings of the Commission, at a rate fixed by the by-laws but not exceeding \$20 for each meeting, and
    (b) his reasonable travelling and living expenses while absent from his ordinary place of residence and in the course of his duties as a member of the Commission, in accordance with the by-laws.
  - (4) The Lieutenant Governor in Council may prescribe the terms of office of any or all of the members of the Commission.
  - (5) The head office of the Commission shall be at or near Edmonton.
