## **BILL 123**

### 1972

THE ALBERTA LORD'S DAY AMENDMENT ACT, 1972

#### (Assented to , 1972)

**H**<sup>ER</sup> MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Alberta Lord's Day Act is hereby amended.

2. Section 4, subsection (1) is amended by adding after clause (a) the following:

(a1) any lottery scheme licensed pursuant to the Criminal Code,

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

#### **Explanatory Notes**

1. This Bill will amend chapter 221 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.

2. This amendment will permit a council as defined in The Alberta Lord's Day Act to authorize bingo games on Sunday.

Section 4, subsection (1), presently reads:

4. (1) When a Sunday by-law is in force and subject to its provisions, it is lawful in the municipality, or in the part or parts thereof specified in the by-law, for any person, after 1:30 o'clock in the afternoon, to provide, engage in or be present at

(a) any game, contest or sport,
(b) any exhibition of an educational, artistic or cultural nature,
(c) any theatrical performance, concert, recital, lecture or other performance, and

(d) any exhibition of moving pictures, or such of them as are specified in the by-law, and which but for this Act would be unlawful under section 6 of the Lord's Day Act (Canada).
