THE BILLIARD ROOMS AMENDMENT ACT, 1972

(Assented to ,1972)

ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Billiard Rooms Act is hereby amended.

2. The following section is added after section 12:

12.1 (1) Except as otherwise provided herein, no person over the age of 14 years but under the age of 16 years shall, unless he provides the person in charge of the billiard room with the written consent of his parent or guardian, be allowed to play any billiard game in a billiard room to which this Act applies, or to frequent, remain or loiter therein.

(2) The person in charge of the billiard room shall request any such person found therein who does not produce such written consent to leave the premises forthwith, and if he refuses to do so reasonable force may be used for the purpose of evicting him from the premises.

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

I. This Bill will amend Chapter 28 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.

2. This new section will permit persons between the ages of 14 and 16 not accompanied by a parent or guardian to enter a billiard room to play any billiard game, and for other permitted purposes, if they produce the written consent of their parent or guardian.
