## AN ACT TO AMEND THE SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT ACT

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1972)

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Social Development Act is hereby amended.*
2. *Section 6 is amended*
  - (a) *by renumbering the section as subsection (1),*
  - (b) *as to renumbered subsection (1) by striking out the words "The Director" and by substituting therefor the words "Subject to subsection (2), the Director", and*
  - (c) *by adding the following subsection:*
    - (2) **Where an employable person is offered but refuses employment, the Director may limit social allowance payments to that which the individual would receive where he employed and remunerated in accordance with the minimum wage requirements under Part 2 of *The Alberta Labour Act*.**
3. *This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*
