AN ACT TO AMEND THE SCHOOL ACT

(Assented to _____, 1972)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The School Act is hereby amended.*

2. *The following section is added after section 16:*

16.1 (1) The Minister, after consultation with Indian representatives and any board concerned, may approve an agreement between a board and Indian representatives whereby

- (a) Indians are represented on the board in addition to the other trustees,
- (b) the functions, duties and liabilities (if any) of the Indian representatives referred to in clause (a) are specified, and
- (c) provision is made for
 - (i) the length of the agreement,
 - (ii) the term of office of any representative,
 - (iii) the qualifications and manner of appointment or election of the representative,
 - (iv) transportation and schooling of Indian children,
 - (v) financial arrangements, and
 - (vi) any other matter to facilitate the education of Indian children.

(2) No agreement under subsection (1) may be made, amended or terminated without the prior approval of the Minister.

3. *This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*
