## AN ACT RESPECTING REMEMBRANCE AND DEDICATION TO PEACE

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1972)

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1.** This Act may be cited as *The Rededication Day Act*.
- 2.** Throughout Alberta, in each and every year, Remembrance Day, the 11th of November, shall be kept and observed as a general holiday for remembrance and dedication to peace, as Rededication Day.
- 3.** Notwithstanding any other Act or any agreement or instrument prescribing terms or conditions of employment, where any person is required to work on Rededication Day, except a person engaged in essential service industries specifically exempted from this Act by order of the Board of Industrial Relations of Alberta, his employer shall pay that person double the normal rate of his pay for such work on that day.
- 4.** This Act comes into force on a date to be fixed by Proclamation.
