THE AGRICULTURAL SERVICE BOARD AMENDMENT ACT, 1973

(Assented to , 1973)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Agricultural Service Board Act is hereby amended.*
- 2. Section 3 is amended by adding the following subsection after subsection (5):*

(6) A person who is a member of a board ceases to be a member of the board if, without being authorized by a resolution of the board to do so, he absents himself from three consecutive regular meetings of the board.
- 3. Section 16, subsection (1) is amended by striking out the word "farm".*
- 4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill amends chapter 7 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.

2. Self-explanatory.

3. Section 16, subsection (1) presently reads:

16. (1) Where a board finds, from investigation and inquiry, that farm land in a municipality included in the area with respect to which the board has been appointed

(a) is impoverished or in the process of becoming impoverished through

(i) weed infestation, or

(ii) wind or water erosion, or

(iii) any other cause that has seriously affected or that may seriously affect the productivity of the land or the welfare of the owner or occupant of the land,

and

(b) may become a menace to the community,
the board shall report its findings to the council or to the Minister of Municipal Affairs, as the case may be.
