AN ACT TO AMEND THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL ACT

(Assented to , 1973)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Department of the Attorney General Act is hereby amended.

2. The following section is added after section 3:

3.1 (1) The Attorney General shall make and submit to the Lieutenant Governor in Council an annual report on the operation of his department.

(2) The report shall

(a) be laid before the Legislative Assembly within 15 days after the commencement of the session next following the end of the year for which the report is made, and

(b) contain such information as may be required to enable the Legislative Assembly to judge the working of the Department of the Attorney General.

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

This Bill will amend The Department of the Attorney General Act by requiring the Attorney General to prepare an annual report on the working of the Department of the Attorney General and place it before the Legislative Assembly.
