THE PUBLIC SERVICE AMENDMENT ACT, 1974

(Assented to , 1974)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Public Service Act is hereby amended.*
- 2. Section 9 is struck out.*
- 3. Section 10, subsection (2) is amended by striking out
the words "the staff establishment of"*
- 4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is
is assented to.*

1. This Bill will amend chapter 298 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.

2. Section 9 presently reads:

9. (1) Each department shall have a staff establishment consisting of those positions in the department for which salaries are authorized

(a) by vote of the Legislature, or

(b) under subsection (3).

(2) Where a department proposes to add a new position or change an existing position by

(a) providing for the addition or change in its departmental estimates for the next ensuing fiscal year, or

(b) requesting authorization under subsection (3),
the positions shall be allocated to a class in a classification plan pursuant to section 10 unless the position is excluded from the plan pursuant to section 11.

(3) The Lieutenant Governor in Council may

(a) change a department's staff establishment by adding, abolishing or changing positions, and

(b) provide for the payment of such salaries as may be required until the end of the fiscal year in which the change occurs.

3. Section 10 (2) is amended consequential to the repeal of section 9.

(2) Each position in the staff establishment of a department shall be allocated to a class in a classification plan by the Commissioner.
