### **THE INTERPROVINCIAL LOTTERY ACT**

*(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1974)*

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** In this Act, "Minister" means the Minister of Culture, Youth and Recreation.

**2.** The Minister may, on behalf of the Government of Alberta, enter into agreements with the governments of any other provinces regarding the conduct and management of a lottery scheme within Alberta and those other provinces.

**3.** The Minister may issue a licence to any person authorizing that person, as agent of the Government of Alberta, to conduct and manage a lottery scheme within Alberta and to carry out the terms of any agreement under section 2.

**4.** A licence issued under section 3 shall contain such terms and conditions as the Minister considers appropriate.

**5.** This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
