THE INTERPROVINCIAL LOTTERY ACT

(Assented to , 1974)

H^{ER} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. In this Act, "Minister" means the Minister of Culture, Youth and Recreation.

2. The Minister may, on behalf of the Government of Alberta, enter into agreements with the governments of any other provinces regarding the conduct and management of a lottery scheme within Alberta and those other provinces.

3. The Minister may issue a licence to any person authorizing that person, as agent of the Government of Alberta, to conduct and manage a lottery scheme within Alberta and to carry out the terms of any agreement under section 2.

4. A licence issued under section 3 shall contain such terms and conditions as the Minister considers appropriate.

5. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
