THE WAGE ASSIGNMENTS ACT

(Assented to

, 1974)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. In this Act
 - (a) "lending institution" means a person who lends money in the ordinary course of his business or his operations;
 - (b) "wages" includes salary.
- 2. Any assignment made after the commencement of this Act by any person of all or any part of his wages to secure the payment of an existing or future indebtedness
 - (a) is against public policy and void, if it is made in favour of a lending institution, or
 - (b) is unenforceable by a lending institution, if it is originally made in favour of a person other than a lending institution and is subsequently acquired by a lending institution.
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
