## THE FORESTS AMENDMENT ACT, 1974

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1974)

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Forests Act is hereby amended.*
2. *Section 21 is amended by striking out the word "Workmen's" and by substituting therefor the word "Workers'".*
3. *Section 48 is struck out and the following is substituted therefor:*

### PART 4

#### OFFENCES AND PENALTIES

**48.** Any person using a forestry road or an airstrip on public lands in contravention of any regulation or of any order of the Minister

- (a) shall pay to the Minister on demand such amount as is equivalent to the cost of restoration if damage has been caused to the forestry road or airstrip by that use, which amount is recoverable as a debt owing to the Crown, and
- (b) is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not more than \$500 and in default of payment to imprisonment for not more than six months.

4. *The headings "PART 4" and "OFFENCES AND PENALTIES" preceding section 49 are struck out.*

5. *This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*

## **Explanatory Notes**

- 1.** This Bill will amend chapter 37 of the Statutes of Alberta 1971.
- 2.** Corrects a reference to The Workers' Compensation Act.
- 3.** This amendment extends the section to include airstrips and specifies the punishment on conviction.
- 4.** Self-explanatory.
