AN ACT TO AMEND THE ALBERTA INSURANCE ACT

(Assented to , 1974)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Alberta Insurance Act is hereby amended.*

2. *The following section is added after section 193:*

193.1 (1) No insurer shall

(a) discriminate against any person with respect to any term or premium of an automobile insurance policy,
or

(b) refuse to insure any person,
because of the race, color, sex or age of that person.

(2) Any person who contravenes subsection (1) is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$1,000 or to imprisonment not exceeding six months or to both fine and imprisonment.

3. *This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill will amend Chapter 187 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.
