## **BILL 210**

### **AN ACT TO AMEND THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY ACT**

*(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1974)*

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Legislative Assembly Act is hereby amended.*

2. *The following section is added after section 49:*

**49.1** (1) When a Legislature is dissolved then, during the period from the dissolution to the day preceding the polling day following the dissolution and notwithstanding the dissolution or anything in this Act, a person who was a member of the Legislative Assembly at the time of the dissolution

- (a) may hold himself out as, and may be referred to as, a member of the Legislative Assembly,
- (b) shall be deemed to be a member of the Legislative Assembly for the purposes of section 6 of *The Commissioners for Oaths Act* and section 3 of *The Notaries Public Act*,
- (c) may continue to avail himself of the offices and services that were available to him as a member of the Assembly at the Legislature Building at Edmonton as though he were a member of the Assembly but not in respect of any of his personal affairs or private business or in connection with the next general election of members of the Legislative Assembly, and
- (d) may continue to act as a member of a committee appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council, and to be paid expenses and allowances pursuant to section 59, subsection (1) as a member of such a committee, as though he were a member of the Assembly.

3. *This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*

## **Explanatory Notes**

**1. This Bill will amend chapter 204 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.**
