## **BILL 214**

### **AN ACT TO AMEND THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS ACT**

*(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1974)*

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

*1. The Department of Consumer Affairs Act is hereby amended.*

*2. The following section is added after section 4:*

**4.1** The Minister shall

- (a) recommend to the Attorney General that any person who contravenes the provisions of any Act under the administration of the Minister be proceeded against according to law;
- (b) do such things as he considers necessary to
  - (i) correct practices that appear to be detrimental to either a business or a consumer; and
  - (ii) stop any practices that are considered unethical business practices.

*3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*
