AN ACT TO AMEND THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS ACT

(Assented to , 1974)

H^{ER} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Department of Consumer Affairs Act is hereby amended.

2. The following section is added after section 4:

- 4.1 The Minister shall
 - (a) recommend to the Attorney General that any person who contravenes the provisions of any Act under the administration of the Minister be proceeded against according to law;
 - (b) do such things as he considers necessary to
 - (i) correct practices that appear to be detrimental to either a business or a consumer; and
 - (ii) stop any practices that are considered unethical business practices.

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
