AN ACT TO AMEND THE WILDLIFE ACT

(Assented to , 1974)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1.** *The Wildlife Act is hereby amended.*
- 2.** *Section 25, subsection (1) is amended by adding at the end thereof the words “, unless the person has a physical disability that would otherwise prevent hunting or shooting and is granted written permission by the Director for a specified period of time.”*
- 3.** *This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill will amend chapter 113 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.

2. Section 25 (1) presently reads:

25. (1) Except in the case of a boat propelled by muscular power, no person
(a) shall have a loaded firearm in or on any kind of vehicle or boat, or
(b) shall discharge a firearm from any kind of vehicle or boat,
whether the vehicle or boat is moving or stationary.
