AN ACT TO AMEND THE ALBERTA HEALTH CARE INSURANCE ACT

(Assented to _____, 1974)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Alberta Health Care Insurance Act is hereby amended.

*2. Section 2, clause (1), subclause (i) is amended by adding at the end thereof the words "but excluding services intended for procuring the miscarriage of a female person, unless the continuation of the pregnancy of such female person would or would be likely to seriously endanger her life and for the purposes of this section, a certificate issued by a therapeutic abortion committee pursuant to section 251, subsection (4), clause (c) of the *Criminal Code* of Canada stating that in its opinion the continuation of the pregnancy of such female person would be likely to seriously endanger her life shall be conclusive evidence of such danger".*

3. This Act comes into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation.
