THE FIREARMS STORAGE ACT

(Assented to _____, 1974)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. In this Act, "firearm" means any barrelled weapon from which any shot, bullet or other missile can be discharged and that is capable of causing serious bodily injury or death to the person, and includes anything that can be adapted for use as a firearm.

2. Every person who engages in the business of selling firearms shall keep such firearms in securely locked facilities at all times except where

- (a) a firearm is removed therefrom so that it may be shown or demonstrated to a potential buyer, or
- (b) a firearm is removed therefrom because it has been sold, or
- (c) the facilities in which the firearms are kept are being cleaned or repaired.

3. Every person who contravenes section 2 is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$500.

4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
