THE ORDERS AND REGULATIONS RATIFICATION ACT

(Assented to , 1974)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. In this Act

- (a) "order" means an order of the Lieutenant Governor in Council;
- (b) "regulation" means a regulation as defined in *The Regulations Act*.

2. Any five members of the Assembly may sign and present in the Assembly a petition to have any orders or regulations ratified by the Legislature.

3. Within five days after the presentation of a petition pursuant to section 2, the Government House Leader in the Assembly shall prepare and introduce in the Assembly a Bill that provides for the ratification by the Legislature of the orders and regulations enumerated in the petition.

4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

This legislation would provide a mechanism for giving legislative sanction to any order in council.
