THE PUBLIC UTILITIES BOARD AMENDMENT ACT, 1975

(Assented to _____, 1975)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Public Utilities Board Act is hereby amended.*

2. *The following section is added after section 70:*

70.1 (1) The Board of its own motion or upon the application of any person having an interest may, and upon the order of the Lieutenant Governor in Council shall,

(a) declare any of the items referred to in section 2, clause (j), subclause (i), (ii) or (iii) not to be a public utility, or

(b) declare that a provision or any section of this Act is not to apply in respect of any public utility referred to in section 2, clause (j), subclause (i), (ii) or (iii) or to an owner of such public utility, and for so long as any such declaration remains unrevoked by the Board the provision therein mentioned has no application in respect of the public utility so designated therein or to the owner of the public utility as such.

(2) An order of the Board under subsection (1) shall be subject to such terms and conditions as the Board may require or which the Lieutenant Governor in Council may impose in an order under subsection (1).

(3) The Board of its own motion or upon the application of any person having an interest may, after notice and hearing, and upon the order of the Lieutenant Governor in Council shall, vary or rescind in whole or in part any order made by the Board pursuant to this section.

3. *This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill will amend chapter 302 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.

2. Authority to declare that certain items are not public utilities and authority to declare that a provision or any section of this Act is not to apply to a public utility.
