## **THE ORDERS AND REGULATIONS RATIFICATION ACT**

*(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1975)*

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1. In this Act**

- (a) "order" means an order of the Lieutenant Governor in Council;
- (b) "regulation" means a regulation as defined in The Regulation Act.

**2.** Any five members of the Assembly may sign and present in the Assembly a petition to have any orders or regulations ratified by the Legislature.

**3.** Within five days after the presentation of a petition pursuant to section 2, the Government House Leader in the Assembly shall prepare and introduce in the Assembly a Bill that provides for the ratification by the Legislature of the orders and regulations enumerated in the petition.

**4.** This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

## **Explanatory Notes**

**This legislation would provide a mechanism for giving legislative sanction to any order in council or regulation.**
