AN ACT TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT

(Assented to _____, 1975)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Municipal Government Act is hereby amended.*

2. *Section 27 is amended*

(a) *by striking out subsection (1) and by substituting the following:*

27. (1) The Council shall by the by-law under section 26

(a) divide the city into any number of areas, to be known as wards, in such a manner that the number of electors residing in each ward is substantially equal, and

(b) specify the number of councillors, being not less than one, to be elected to represent each ward.

(b) *as to subsection (3) by adding at the end thereof the words "or the number of councillors to be elected to represent each ward".*

3. *This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill will amend Chapter 246 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1970.

2. Section 27, subsections (1) and (3) presently read:

- 27. (1) The council shall by the by-law under section 26**
- (a) divide the city into not less than three nor more than 10 areas, to be known as wards, in such a manner that the number of electors residing in each ward is substantially equal, and**
 - (b) specify the number of councillors, being not less than two, to be elected to represent each ward.**
- (3) Subject to subsection (1) the council may by by-law alter the boundaries of any or all wards or the number of wards.**
