### **AN ACT TO AMEND THE WILDLIFE ACT**

*(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1975)*

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Wildlife Act is hereby amended.*
2. *Section 25, is amended by adding at the end thereof the words,*  
(6) Subsection (1) shall not apply to a person who has a physical disability that would prevent hunting or shooting except from a mechanically propelled vehicle or boat, provided such person is granted written permission by the Director for a specified period of time to hunt or shoot from a mechanically propelled vehicle or boat on the grounds of such disability.
3. *This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*

## Explanatory Notes

**1.** This Bill will amend chapter 113 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1970.

**2.** Section 25 (1) presently reads:

25. (1) Except in the case of a boat propelled by muscular power, no person

- (a) Shall have a loaded firearm in or on any kind of vehicle or boat or
- (b) shall discharge a firearm from any kind of vehicle or boat, whether the vehicle or boat is moving or stationary.
