AN ACT TO LIMIT SMOKING IN PUBLIC PLACES

(Assented to

, 1974)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. Smoking tobacco in any form is a nuisance to the public and a danger to public health if done in
 - (a) those parts of any hospital, indoor theatre, library, art museum, concert hall or courtroom to which members of the public have access as a matter of right, or
 - (b) any bus or elevator used regularly by the public, or
 - (c) school classrooms and all such other places where children are required to attend and places which are provided primarily for children or which are principally frequented by children, or
 - (d) those parts of any shopping areas and all other public or private places or vehicles frequented by the public or to which the public is invited, which are posted as no-smoking areas, or
 - (e) the Assembly Chamber of the Legislature.
- 2. A person who smokes any form of tobacco in any area mentioned in Section 1 is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than \$10 and not more than \$100.
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
