#### THE FINANCIAL ADMINISTRATION AMENDMENT ACT, 1975

(Assented to

, 1975)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Financial Administration Act is hereby amended.
- 2. Section 12, subsection (2) is amended by striking out clause (c) and by substituting the following:
  - (c) shall be paid a salary at the rate of \$43,500 a year, effective as of August 1, 1974, which shall be charged to and paid out of the General Revenue Fund.
  - 3. Section 33 is amended
    - (a) as to subsection (2) by striking out clause (a) and by substituting the following:
      - (a) be prepared under the authority of the Auditor, and
    - (b) as to subsection (5) by striking out the words "in his department" and substituting the words "under his authority".
- 4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to and upon so coming into force section 3 shall be deemed to have been in force at all times on and after April 16, 1975.

### **Explanatory Notes**

- 1. This Bill will amend chapter 142 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.
  - 2. Section 12, subsection (2), clause (c) presently reads:
    - (2) The Provincial Auditor
    - (c) shall be paid a salary at the rate of \$37,500 a year, effective as of January 1, 1974, which shall be charged to and paid out of the General Revenue Fund.
  - 3. Section 33, subsections (2) and (5) presently read:
    - (2) Cheques and orders shall
    - (a) be prepared in the Auditor's office,
    - (b) be signed by the Auditor or clerk appointed by the Auditor for that purpose, and  $% \left( 1\right) =\left( 1\right) +\left( 1\right$
    - (c) then forwarded to the Treasury Department for the signature of the Treasurer or his deputy or any person appointed by the Treasurer for that purpose.
    - (5) The Treasurer shall ensure that there is kept in his department a record in which shall be entered particulars of all cheques and orders signed by him and which shall give in each case the bank or treasury branch upon which it is drawn, the date of issue and the serial number thereof.
